Limit your trips



Protect your home,
close all exits.
Stay away from bay
windows during the
event



Stay away
and don't go out
under any
circumstances
In case of return to
quiet time do not go
out, it is likely the
eye of the cyclone



Give assistance to
clear the lines of
communication with
the authorization of
the authorities



Stay informed of
the situation due to
the passage of the
phenomenon on the
island



Store equipment
and tools in an
accessible location



Clean gutters
to facilitate water
evacuation...



Cut electrical current
from the network and
dismantle TV antennas



Drink bottled
water or treat tap
water



Collect dead animals
to prevent the
spread of disease



Clear outside spaces
and if necessary
consolidate the house



Protect your personal
documents from water
by keeping them
in a safe place



Get ready to proceed
with the consolidation
of exits



Try to stay calm.
The situation will
change quickly



Do not clutter the
telephone network
except in case of
emergency



Do not cross
submerged rafts or
flooded gullies
